## **Incident Reported in Billings County**

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Oil and Gas Division was notified of a tank leak occurring Thursday, December 26 at the SFTU 4-25 well, approximately 15 miles SE of Medora, North Dakota.

SCOUT ENERGY MANAGEMENT LLC reported Friday that about 280 barrels of produced water were released on location. At the time of reporting 260 barrels of produced water had been recovered.

A North Dakota Oil and Gas inspector has been to the location and will monitor any additional cleanup required.
