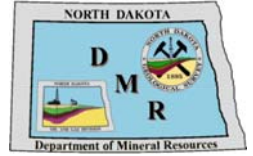




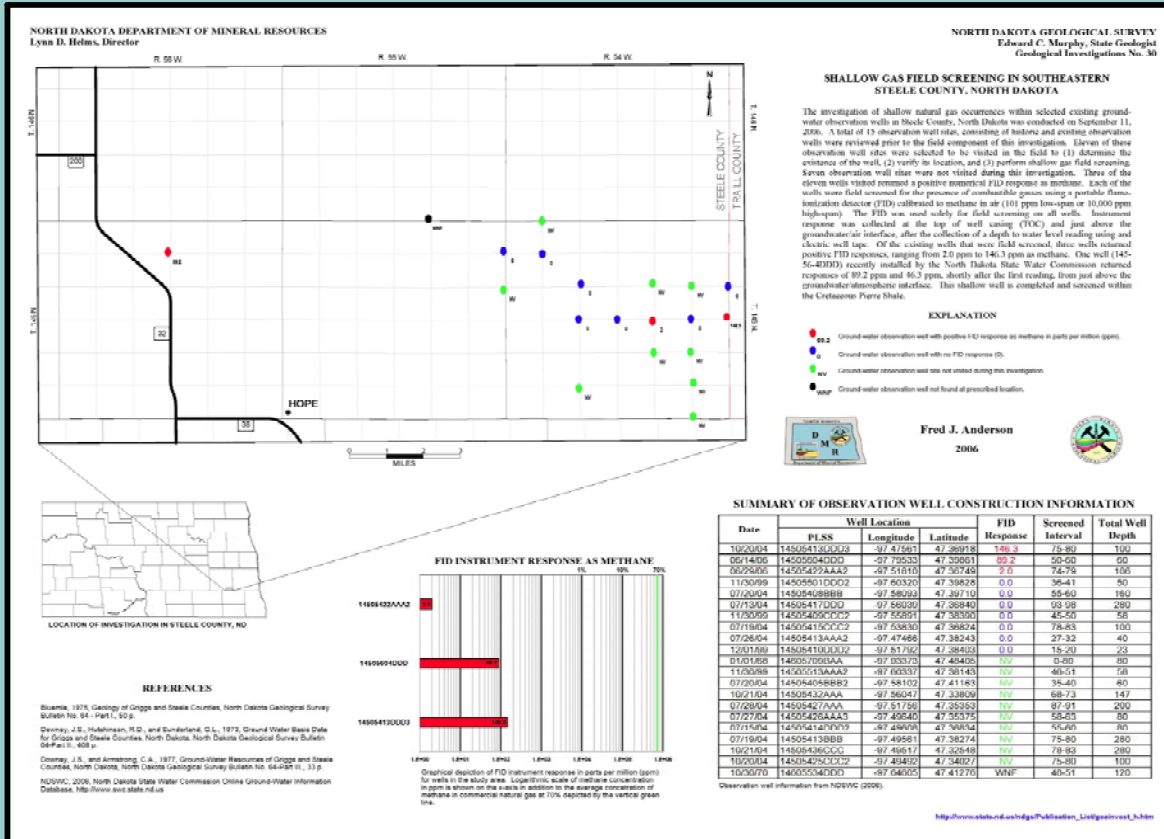

NDGS GEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS No. 30 (GI-30)

The North Dakota Geological Survey has recently completed an investigation into the occurrence of natural gas in shallow ground-water observation wells in southeastern Steele County, North Dakota. Eleven wells sites were reviewed and visited during the investigation. Each existing observation well was field screened with a flame-ionization detector (FID) for the presence of methane. The locations of the existing observation wells in place within the county are depicted along with the associated FID instrument response.
