RECENT

OAHE FORMATION

Qal Alluvium

Brownish gray to black sand, silt, clay, and lenses of gravel; floodplain deposits along recent drainages. Includes lower terrace deposits. Typically less than 50 feet thick.

RECENT/PLEISTOCENE

Landslide Deposits Qls

> Variable mixture of strata and deposits that have slid to the base of steep slopes.

PLEISTOCENE

COLEHARBOR GROUP

Qcg Glacial Deposits

Grayish brown, sandy, siltly, bouldery clay with lenses of sand and gravel (glacial till). May occasionally include thick deposits of glacial outwash.

Qsc **Glacial Channels**



Generally contain less than 50 feet of channel fill deposits (sand and gravel, silt, and clay) typically much narrower than the proglacial
