- (1) This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 a.m. on the 28th day of August, 2008.
- (2) Continental Resources, Inc. (Continental) has recently drilled their Arvid #1-34H well, located in the SW/4 SE/4 Section 34, Township 161 North, Range 95 West, Divide County, North Dakota.
- (3) Continental is the owner of an interest in an oil and gas leasehold estate in a spacing unit for the Sadler-Bakken Pool described as all of Sections 27 and 34, Township 161 North, Range 95 West, Divide County, North Dakota.
- (4) Continental has applied for an order of the Commission pooling all interests in said spacing unit and authorizing the recovery of a risk penalty from each nonparticipating owner.
- (5) The Commission received a letter on August 25, 2008 from Branex Resources, Inc., an owner of minerals under the spacing unit, objecting to the risk penalty being applied to their minerals.
- (6) Counsel for Continental requests that this case be continued to the regularly scheduled hearing in September 2008.
