IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That this case be, and is hereby, dismissed without prejudice.

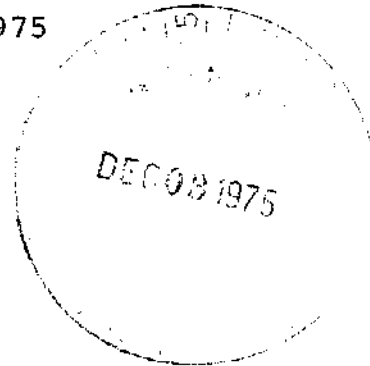



3.


That there are separately owned interests in all or part




