COMES NOW the appellant, Placid Oil Co., and respectfully alleges as follows:

- 1. That it is the owner of an interest in the oil and gas leasehold estate underlying the Si of Section 30, Township 140 North, Range 96 West, Stark County, North Dakota.
- 2. That by application for permit to drill dated June 29, 1993, received by the Commission on June 30, 1993, appellant sought the issuance of a permit to drill a well to a depth sufficient to test the Lodgepole formation at a location approximately 760 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 30, Township 140 North, Range 96 West, Stark County, North Dakota. Upon information and belief, at the time the Commission received appellant's application, no other permits to drill had been issued in the Lodgepole spacing unit consisting of the Si of said Section 30, nor had any applications for such permits been received by the Commission.
- 3. By letter dated July 2, 1993, appellant's application was returned to appellant "because it cannot be approved." Said letter also references the approval and issuance of an APD to Conoco, Inc. for a Lodgepole test in the SE2 of Section 30. The letter does

- 4. Upon information and belief, appellant alleges that its application was not approved by the Commission prior to Conoco's filing of an application solely because appellant did not, on June 30, 1993, have a bond on file with the Commission. Section 43-02-03-15 requires the submittal of a bond "prior to commencing drilling operations." Section 43-02-03-16 of the North Dakota Administrative Code requires an application for permit to drill to be accompanied by a plat. However, nothing in either regulation, or in any of the other statutes, rules, or regulations governing the Commission, requires the filing of a bond prior to obtaining a permit to drill, so long as a bond is obtained prior to commencing drilling operations.
- 5. Section 43-02-03-16 specifically allows an applicant for permit to drill to appeal a decision of the director denying a permit to the Commission. Pursuant to that authority, appellant hereby appeals the July 2, 1993 termination of the director, acting by and through the assistant director, denying the appellant's application for permit to drill.

WHEREFORE, the applicant respectfully requests that the Commission reverse the decision of the director and issue a permit in accordance with appellant's application dated June 29, 1993. To the extent such relief requires the cancellation or revocation of the permit issued to Conoco, Inc., such relief is hereby requested on the basis that Conoco, or its representatives, had full


