COMES NOW the applicant, Conoco Inc. ("Conoco"), and respectfully shows the
North Dakota Industrial Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1.

That Conoco is the owner of an interest in the oil and gas leasehold estate in the
following described lands:

- a) N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 5-T139N-R96W
- b) N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 31-T140N-R96W
- c) S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 31-T140N-R96W
- d) W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32-T140N-R96W

2.

That such lands are currently within an area defined by the Commission as the field boundaries for the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool.

3.

That pursuant to Commission Order No. 6607 entered in Case No. 5712, dated April 8, 1993, temporary spacing for the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool has been established at one well to 320 acres.

4.

That Conoco is the operator of the Conoco - Dickinson State No. 74 well located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 32, drilled and completed as a producer of oil and gas in the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool.

5.

That Conoco is the operator of the Conoco - Kadrmas No. 75 well located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, drilled and completed as a producer of oil and gas in the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool.

6.

That Conoco is the operator of the Conoco - Frenzel No. 79 well located in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, drilled and completed as a producer of oil and gas in the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool.

7.

That Conoco is the operator of the Conoco - Dickinson State "A" No. 83 well located in the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of the Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section 5, currently drilling with an anticipated completion in the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool.

8.

That Conoco is desirous to produce and commingle production from the following four wells into a central tank battery or production facility:

- a) Conoco - Dickinson No. 74 well
- b) Conoco - Kadrmas No. 75 well
- c) Conoco - Frenzel No. 79 well
- d) Conoco - Dickinson State "A" No. 83

That in the opinion of Conoco, granting the application of Conoco herein will result in safer and more efficient operations and consequently result in the greater ultimate recovery of oil and gas from the pool in a manner which will protect correlative rights.

That Conoco therefore requests that the Commission authorize the commingling of production from the afore-mentioned wells in the Dickinson-Lodgepole Pool, Stark County, North Dakota, and such further and additional relief as the Commission deems appropriate.

WHEREFORE, Conoco respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing at the regularly scheduled December 15, 1993 meeting of the Commission and thereafter the

Commission enter its Order granting the relief requested and such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.



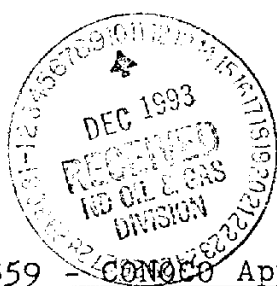

Gentlemen:

I am one of the royalty owners in the Well No. 74 in the Dickinson Lodgepole, Stark County.

Conoco is now making application to produce and commingle production of this well with three other wells; namely, Kadrmas No. 75 Well, Frenzel No. 79 Well, and Dickinson State "A" Well No. 83.

I am quite concerned about this commingling due to the way Conoco has handled the production from Well No. 74. We have been charged high transportation/treatment fees for the gas and distillate production. In fact, the transportation/treatment fees exceeded the value of the product for the month of August.

It appears that the royalty owners are in fact paying for the pipe line Conoco had to build to deliver the products. I also have been informed by knowledgeable persons that are not receiving market price for these products. I have requested some information from Conoco about this operation (as have several other royalty owners) and we have yet to receive a reply from Conoco.

I would like to know how this commingling operation will work - - how will we know that we are being paid for the production from Well No. 74? What can we expect in the future as a result of this commingling? Does this lead to unitizing, or some other method that will benefit Conoco?

I am opposing Conoco's request for commingling until they give us some answers and that the royalty owners are assured that their rights and interests will be protected.
