(3) The original application filed by SM Energy incorrectly identified the Burtman 14-23HS well as being located in Sections 14 and 23, Township 161 North, Range 99 West, Divide County, North Dakota, and thus was advertised as such. The actual spacing unit of the Burtman 14-23HS well is Sections 26 and 35, Township 161 North, Range 99 West, Divide County, North Dakota.

(4) Case No. 25962 was scheduled for hearing on July 26, 2017 to correct the advertising mistake.

(5) This case should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) This case is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
